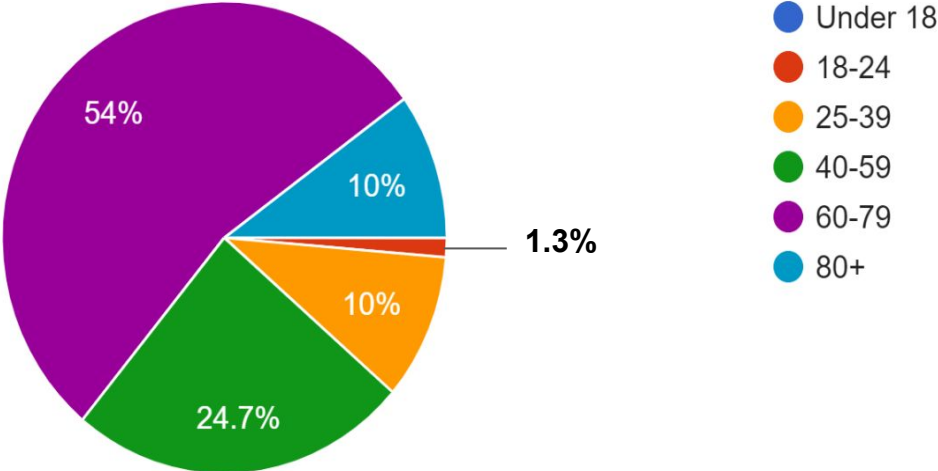

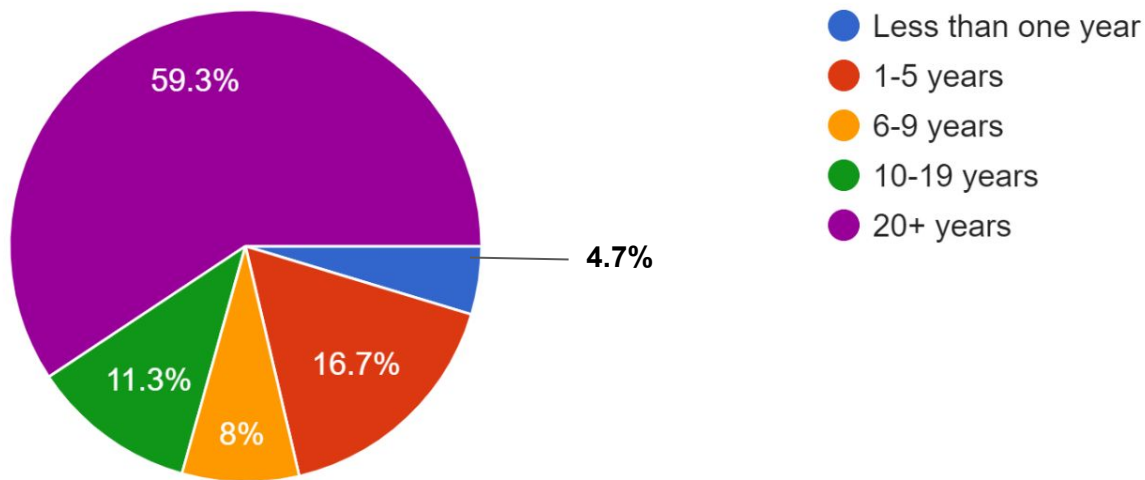
# What is your age?

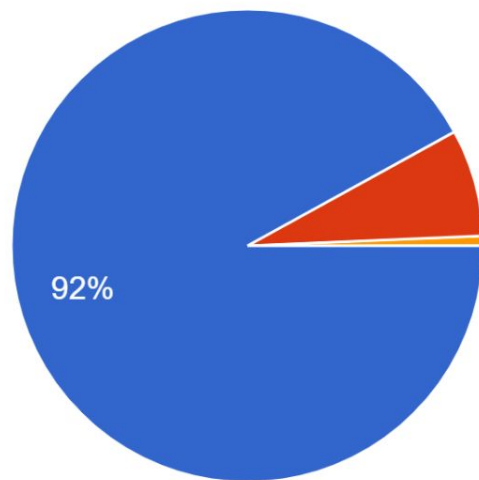
## How long have you been attending St. Mark United Methodist Church?

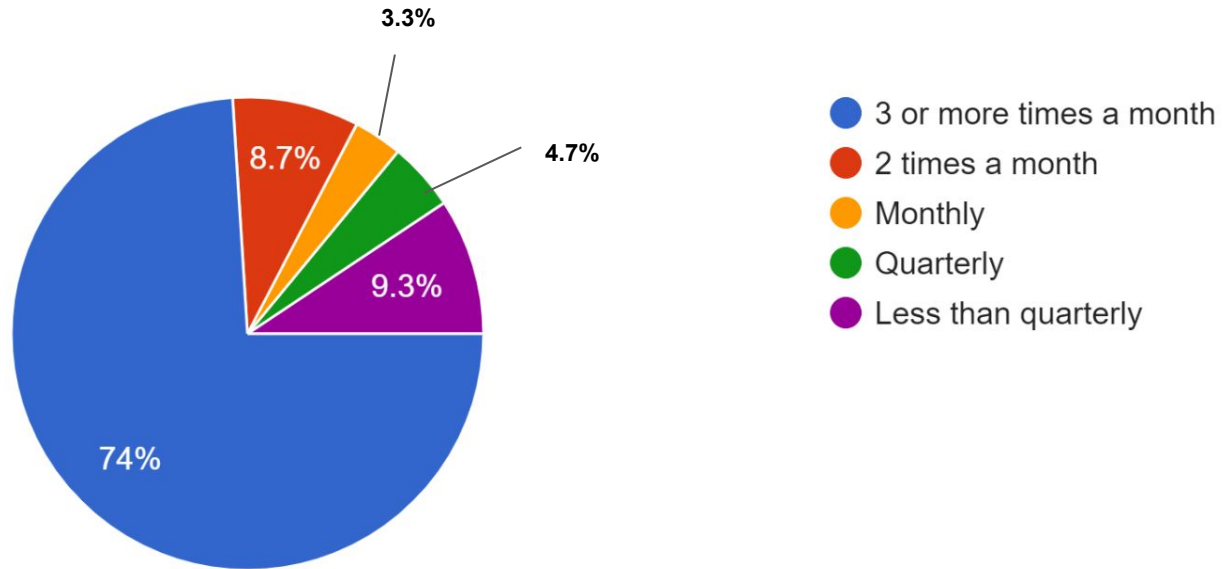

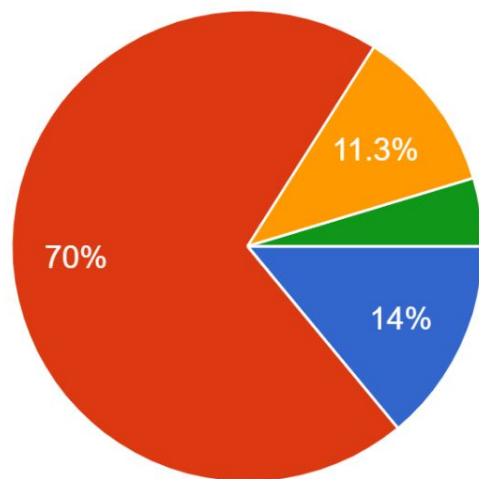
# How often do you attend a worship service at St. Mark (on campus or virtually)?

When you attend a worship service at St. Mark (on campus or virtually), which service do you normally attend?

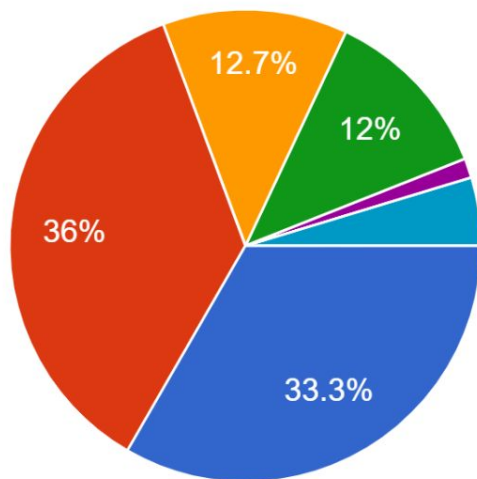

## With whom do you feel the MOST connected at St. Mark?

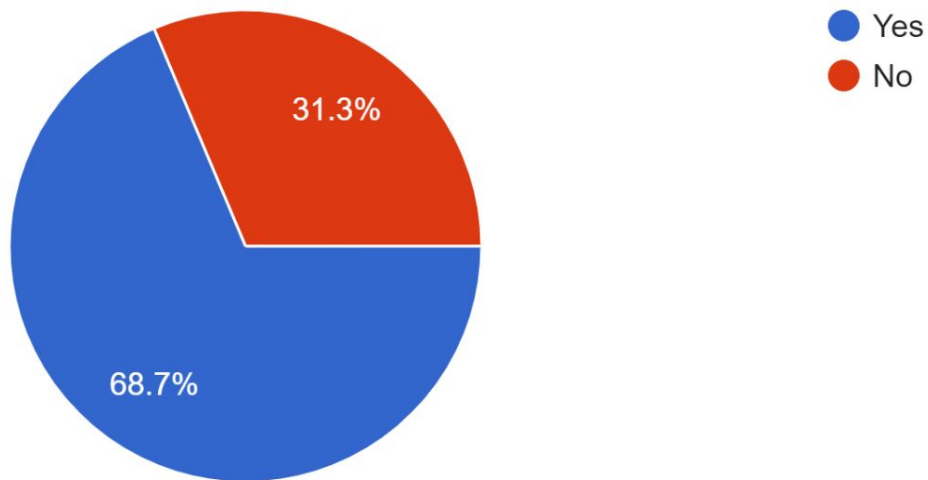

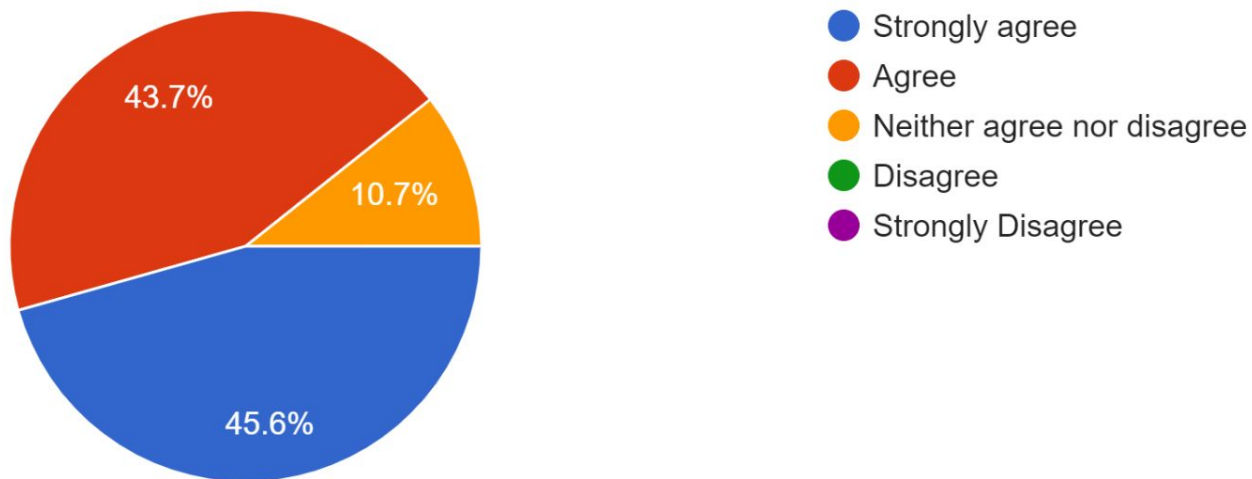

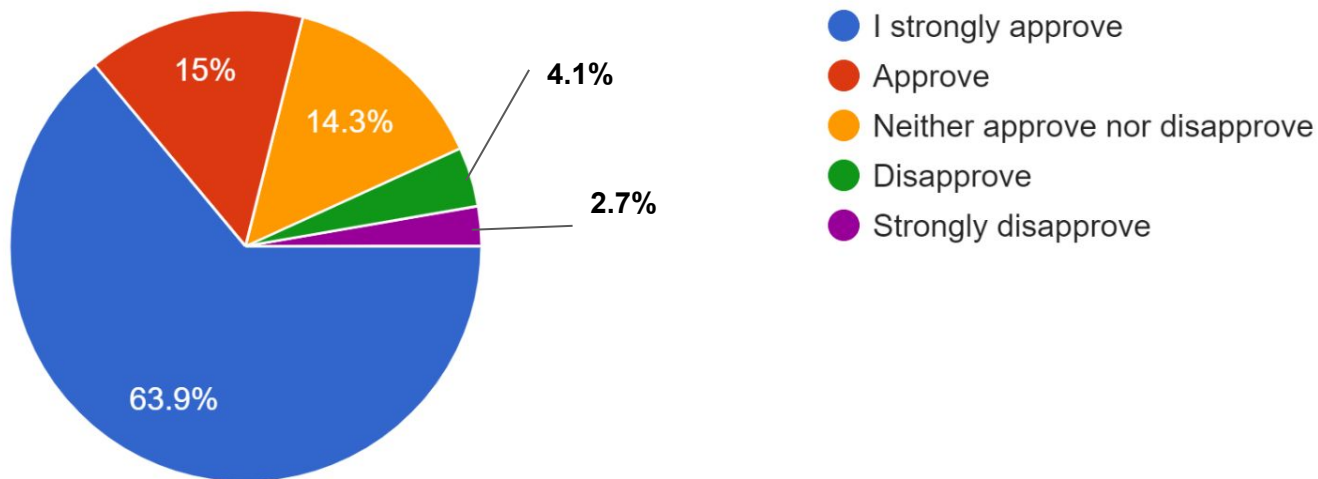

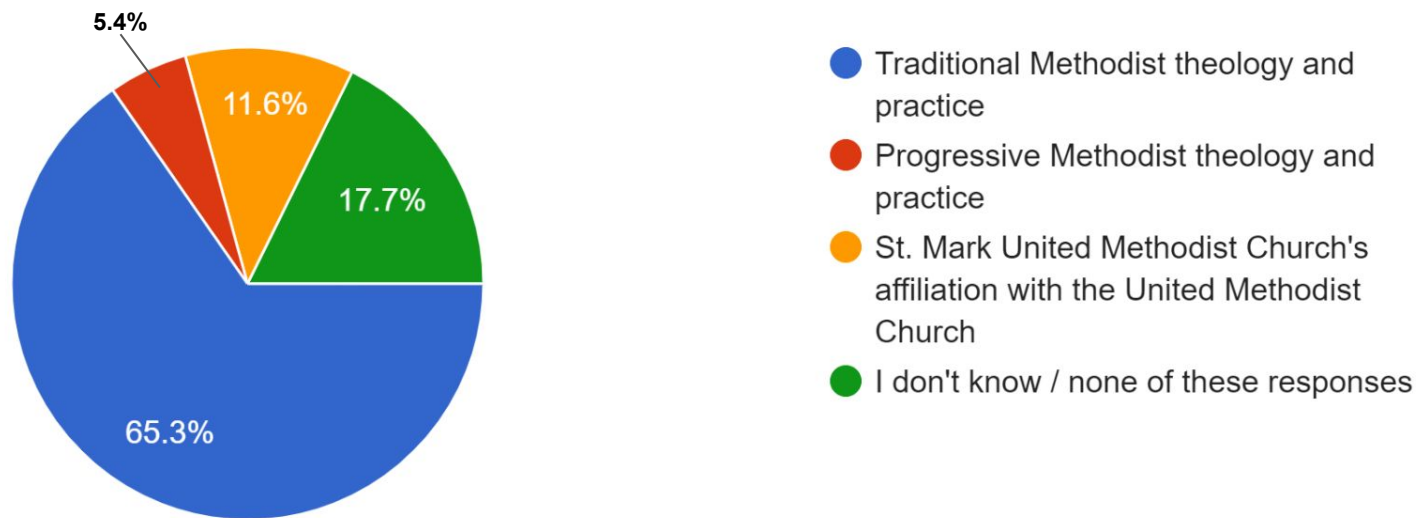

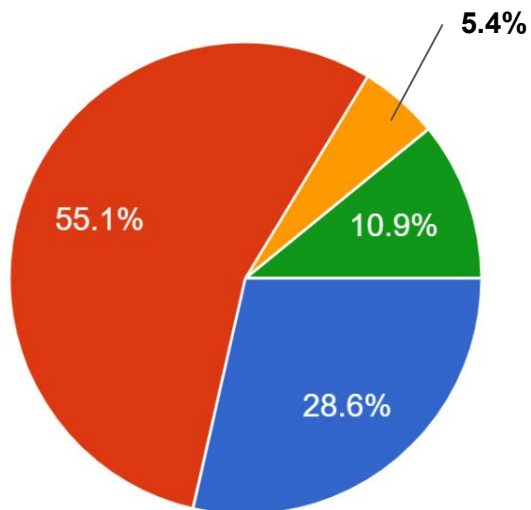
Of the following options, which ONE influences your attendance in this United Methodist Church?
